COMMENTS:

The Pinot Noir fruit of Santa Maria Valley is brooding and moody, with notes of cherries, oriental spice and dark plums. This dynamic wine displays an arresting aromatic profile that ranges from black cherry and acacia flowers to forest floor and light smoke to vanilla and anise. On the mouth, there are ample notes of Bing cherries, strawberries, vanilla, cinnamon and dried herbs. Drinkable in its youth, it will also benefit from decanting.
