The 2007 Gypsy (47% Grenache, 22% Mourvèdre, 19% Counoise, and the rest Cinsault and other Rhone varieties) exhibits a lighter medium ruby color as well as lots of strawberry, cherry, pepper, and sandy, loamy soil notes. A California version of a French Côtes du Rhône, it is a charming, endearing red with a heady finish, and no hard edges. Enjoy it over the next 2-3 years. ~ Robert M. Parker, Jr.

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
